

Sal's empty eyes seem to have been living only on memories since he lost Zoe, the love of his life: memories like fragments of a shattered mirror that cannot be put back together. His sister Ebe, who observes her brother with growing concern, suggests he turn to Another End, a new technology that promises to ease the pain of separation by briefly bringing back to life the consciousness of those who have died. Sal finds Zoe again in this way, but in the body of another woman. A body he does not know but in which he is mysteriously able to recognise his wife. What was broken suddenly seems to come together again. In fact, Another End grants Sal the time to share a little more life with Zoe, to love her again, to be loved by her, to say goodbye in the end. But this is a fragile, ephemeral, insidious joy and, having arrived at the end of the programme, Sal has no intention of meekly watching as his love dissolves in the definitive loss of his wife. He tries to find her in Ava, the woman who had lent her body to Zoe's consciousness. Perhaps love really does survive and eternity is promised through physical bodies.



The year is 1800; Sant Ignazio College, a decrepit old musical institute for girls, near Venice. Here lives "the Mute", a silent, solitary maid tasked with the humblest chores. No one knows that her name is Teresa; no one suspects that she possesses an extraordinary talent that enables her to sense the harmony of the universe and reshape reality through music. While everyone at the college is making a huge fuss about the imminent visit of the newly enthroned Pope, and the old chapel master is struggling to put together a new composition for the Pontifex, Teresa makes a discovery in a storeroom: a brand-new invention, a beautiful instrument – a pianoforte. Costanza has a famous father. Giuseppe Quatriglio was a Sicilian journalist, author and globetrotter. Smart, hungry for life, good-looking. He filled a house with books, texts and mementos. It was in this rich environment that Costanza grew up. In 2010, she begins filming her father, without extra lighting, without prep, just him in his bathrobe. With one hand she hauls down the "1995-2001" box for him from the top shelf, with the other hand she holds the camera. Upon her father's death she decides to make The Secret Drawer. She stays on and keeps filming – using both hands like a virtuoso. While she empties his house, the film jets through post-war Europe with her father and the world is revealed from a Mediterranean perspective, the daughter stays in the house, staging and performing her relationship with her father. His books and boxes are catalogued, his sense of order transferred. A powerful tidying up process, an upheaval. Yet in these moments of dissolution, a wealth is revealed – and a father. "This archive is showing us a much friendlier person than I thought."



In a gritty and gloomy village, detective Enzo Vitello becomes increasingly obsessed with tracking down the serial killer "Dostoyevsky". The killer has a habit of leaving letters next to his victims' bodies in which he describes their last moments. Seduced by the murderer's nihilistic notes, and driven by his own inner demons, Vitello embarks on a correspondence with Dostoyevsky outside the knowledge of his investigative team. This exchange drives Vitello into the darker corners of his soul and forces him to confront a secret from his past – a secret that led him to abandon his daughter Ambra when she was a toddler. Vitello penetrates deep into the murderer's head, but also opens the doors to his own thoughts and emotions. A gruelling game of cat and mouse develops.

When, in an incredible twist of fate, Rocco meets Supersex, he discovers that the two share the same superpower. This can save him from the difficult circumstances of his life, but it also forces him to pay the highest price: to give up love forever, or so it seems. The series depicts a life in the porn industry. It is about sex and passion but also about death. The story examines how masculinity is constructed and which questions of desire and power still dominate the relationship between men and women today.



Set in modern-day Tangier, In *Praise of Slowness* follows the laborious journey of a man collecting empty bottles, which he later sells to bleach vendors that roam the labyrinthic streets of the old city. In the face of the global economic and technological forces reshaping the city of Tangier, the profession of the bleach vendors seems to be on the verge of disappearing, yet this film portrait of their supply chain – and notably their insistent chanting – conveys acoustic and visual images of endurance. In *Praise of Slowness* speaks to the accelerated urbanization and industrialization of Tangier, but also attests to how locally situated choreographies of slowness articulate modes of resistance to the speed of capitalism.

Jasmine Trinca, born in Rome in 1981, took on her first cinema role in Nanni Moretti's The Son's Room in 2001. She also worked with Moretti in The Caiman (2006) and shot Romanzo Criminale (2006, Berlinale Competition) and The Big Dream (2009) with Michele Placido. In 2007, she was honoured as a European Shooting Star at the Berlinale, and two years later she received the Marcello Mastroianni Award at the Venice Film Festival. In France, she made the films House of Tolerance (2011) and Saint Laurent (2014) with Bertrand Bonello. Other directors with whom she has worked in front of the camera include Marco Tullio Giordana (The Best of Youth, 2003), Valeria Golino (Miele, 2013, Euphoria, 2018), Pierre Morel (The Gunman, 2015), the Taviani brothers (Wondrous Boccaccio, 2015) and Ildikó Enyedi (The Story of My Wife, 2021). For Sergio Castellitto's Lucky (2017), she not only received the Un Certain Regard Prize for Best Actress at Cannes, but also various Italian film awards. Trinca's directorial debut *Marcel!* celebrated its world premiere at the Cannes Film Festival in 2022.

Italian-born director Tizza Covi studied photography in Vienna and soon after started collaborating with Rainer Frimmel on photography, theatre, and film projects. Their documentary Babooska (2006) won the Wolfgang Staudte Award in the Forum section, their debut feature, La Pivellina (2009), premiered at Cannes and was later screened at the Berlinale in the Generation section. Their second feature, The Shine of the Day, which screened in Perspektive Deutsches Kino in 2013, won the Silver Leopard at Locarno for Best Actor. Their documentary Notes from the Underworld (Panorama 2020) received a Special Mention at the Berlinale Documentary Award. In 2022, their most recent film, Vera, won Best Directors and Best Actress in the Orizonti Section of the Venice Film Festival.


Valentina Bellè studied acting at the Lee Strasberg Theatre & Film Institute in New York and Italy's National Film School (CSC). In 2014, she was in *The Obscene Life* by Renato De Maria (Venice Film Festival), La Buca by Daniele Ciprì and Wondrous Boccaccio, the first of two films directed by Paolo and Vittorio Taviani. The second Taviani Brothers film, Rainbow: A Private Affair, premiered in the 2017 Toronto International Film Festival. She has also appeared in The Furlough, Stories of Love That Cannot Belong to This World (Locarno Film Festival) and Into the Labyrinth, with Toni Servillo and Dustin Hoffman. In 2023 Valentina was in two films in competition at the Venice Film Festival: Ferrari and Lubo. Her many TV roles include Genius: Picasso with Antonio Banderas; Medici: Masters of Florence; Catch-22, a miniseries by George Clooney and The Good Mothers for which she won the Italian Nastro D'Argento Award for Supporting Actress in 2023. Her next project is La Vita Accanto by Marco Tullio Giordana.
