The Festival presents in Spain, in original version with Spanish subtitles, premieres of feature films, documentaries and short films, hosen from among the Italian productions selected in the year by the most prestigious international cinema festivals. The Institute also collaborates with the Giffoni Film Festival with a new section of the Festival - II Festival del cinema italiano dei piccoli - dedicated to children and young people. The Festival represents a valid and effective tool to increase the popularity of contemporary Italian cinema in Spain among the audience of movie lovers and, thanks to the work carried out by Cultural Institute in Madrid for Spanish subtitling, also for commercial.

The Directorate General for Cinema and Audiovisual of the Italian Ministry of Culture DGCA - MiC promotes the creation, production, distribution and circulation of film and audiovisual works, professional training, the opening and modernisation of cinemas and the adaptation of the film industry to technological developments.

DGCA - MiC represents Italy before the EU, the Council of Europe, other international bodies and international funds that issue supranational support to the sector (Creative Europe - MEDIA sub-programme, Eurimages, Ibermedia).

It also manages bilateral funds with similar institutions in other countries to sustain the development of international co-productions. DGCA - MiC supports Cinecittà, Fondazione La Biennale di Venezia, Centro Sperimentale di Cinematografia, Museo nazionale del Cinema Fondazione Maria Adriana Prolo-Archivi di fotografia, cinema ed immagine, Fondazione Cineteca di Bologna, Cineteca italiana di Milano and Cineteca del Friuli di Gemona del Friuli.

DGCA - MiC hosts the Film Commissions' Coordination Body and oversees the portal for locations and national and regional production incentives www.italy-formovies.com run by Cinecittà in partnership with the Italian Film Commissions Association.

Cinecittà is a state-owned company whose main shareholder is the Italian Ministry of Culture (MiC).

Main departments and activities include:

- Managing the legendary Cinecittà Studios and labs, (founded in 1937), which provides the film and audiovisual industry with a range of essential services: from sound stages, set design and creation to executive production, post-production and restoration expertise.
- Promoting Italian Contemporary Cinema in the World, as the Italian Member of EFP European Film Promotion. This includes support at international Festivals, organization of themed events and the publication of an Online Database monitoring new productions and the international circulation of movies.

SYNOPSIS

Despite directing hundreds of features, shorts, and documentaries that were wildly popular from Naples to New York, pioneering director Elvira Notari was relegated to the margins of film history for half a century. To fill these silences, "In Transit" weaves together the voices of those who celebrate her legacy today, from leading experts who rediscovered and restored her films to new generations encountering her for the first time. Through their eyes, we explore her surviving works and the vibrant culture from which they emerged. At the center of the story, her defiance of conventions: a woman in a man's world, Elvira created a style poised between realism and staged drama, deeply rooted in Neapolitan traditions. A vision that clashed with fascist censorship yet found the embrace of audiences on both sides of the ocean.




