Jorge Thielen-Armand's debut feature film *La Soledad* (2016) premiered at the 73rd Venice International Film Festival and garnered over a dozen awards across a 50+ festival run, notably Miami Film Festival's Audience Award and the French Critics' Prize at the Festival of Latin American Cinema in Biarritz. The ICA (Institute of Contemporary Arts) and MUBI released the film theatrically in the UK. His second film *La Fortaleza* premiered in competition in IFFR Rotterdam and was subsequently sold to HBO Europe.

SYNOPSIS OF PROJECT

Carolina, a middle-aged woman with a taste for risk, returns to Venezuela after 20 years to sell her father's cacao plantation. The land invigorates her with its beauty, but also terrifies her with memories of a kidnapping she was victim to. Soon she discovers the plantation is occupied by its former workers, who are determined to stay at all costs. A game of manipulation ensues, where victims become as violent as their oppressors. No one will escape the death that rules this land.

DIRECTOR'S STATEMENT

Death Has No Master is a fiction, but what is written in the script happens daily in Venezuela, including the violence, the magic, the armed groups with skull masks, the looting of graves, the class co-dependence... all of it. Through the metaphor of this fatal fight for a house, I want to show this reality unfiltered, but especially illuminate what it's at stake: the future of generations to come, and life itself.

The film's setup recalls an Acid Western; our characters' journey is toward death and a society that becomes nightmarish. Venezuela is like a beast that surrounds the house, threatening to crush the characters at all times. It is a beast with a thousand faces, and the fear is anonymous. No one knows who is who, or where they will come from. Meanwhile, our protagonist's doings act as microcosm of colonialism and its inescapable consequences.
