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Introduction

The British Film Institute (BFI), in collaboration with the Directorate General for Cinema and Audiovisual of the Ministry of Culture in Italy (DGCA-MiC), Cinecittà, and the Italian Cultural Institute of London, are organising a day of discussion and business meetings on the subject of UK-Italy co-production during the 68th BFI London Film Festival in partnership with American Express (LFF) 2024.

This brochure presents the UK producers selected by the BFI to meet with their Italian counterparts, with the aim of furthering bilateral coproduction and collaboration.

About the British Film Institute (BFI)

As the UK's lead organisation for film, the BFI works closely with industry and government to ensure the continued growth of the UK's screen industries, both internationally and in the UK. A cultural charity and National Lottery distributor, we support, nurture and promote the art of film, television and the moving image, investing in development, production, distribution, sales, export, film heritage, and education.

We manage the UK Global Screen Fund, financed by the UK Government's Department for Culture, Media and Sport (DCMS), which invests £7m a year in UK international co-productions, the international distribution of UK content, and international business development, as well as the ScreenUK platform which promotes UK screen content internationally.

The BFI Certification Unit is the first point of contact for accessing the UK's Creative Sector Tax Reliefs for film, high-end television, animation and video games.

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Aluna Entertainment is the London-based film & TV production company founded by actress Vanessa Kirby, alongside Lauren Dark and Juliet Kirby. Aluna is developing a wide slate of projects that focus on the unexplored female experience. In 2023, Aluna Exec produced the Swiss Oscar entry THUNDER from director Carmen Jacquier, which made its world premiere at the 2022 Toronto International Film Festival. This year, Aluna shot NIGHT ALWAYS COMES for Netflix and produced two documentaries set for 2025.



Consisting of perennial underachievers, the team of five includes a win-at-all-costs captain, a pregnant teammate, and an exchange student harbouring a staggering secret. These misfits must confront egos, self-sabotage, bullies, cheating, and hormones before they can even dream of capturing that elusive gold medal.

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BROUHAHA ENTERTAINMENT

Formed in 2021, Brouhaha Entertainment receives backing from the Calculus Creative Content EIS Fund, launched in 2019 to support British indie firms. Troy Lum and Andrew Mason have been involved in iconic cinema in their native Australia and abroad. Their combined filmography includes titles such as SAVING MR BANKS, ADORATION, THE WATER DIVINER, THE MATRIX and DARK CITY.

BAFTA and Academy-nominated producer Gabrielle Tana has been behind some of the UK's most successful and highly acclaimed independent films of recent years. In 1996, she founded Magnolia Mae Films with partner Carolyn Marks Blackwood. Through Magnolia Mae, she has produced some of the UK's most successful independent films of recent years, including THE DIG (2021), THE WHITE CROW (2019), PHILOMENA (2013), THE INVISIBLE WOMAN (2013) and THE DUCHESS (2008). In 2022 Gabrielle produced Ron Howard's THIRTEEN LIVES and Patrick Dickinson's debut COTTONTAIL.

Other credits include MY ZOE (2020), DANCER (2016), the award-winning documentary about Sergei Polunin, CORIOLANUS (2011), and the Oscar-nominated documentary ON THE ROPES (1999). In collaboration with Baby Cow Films, Gabrielle has also executive produced STAN & OLLIE (2018) and MINDHORN (2016). In 2021, Gabrielle formed a new company, Brouhaha, a joint venture with the Australian producers Troy Lum and Andrew Mason. Brouhaha's first UK production, FIREBRAND, directed by Karim Aïnouz and starring Alicia Vikander and Jude Law, was selected for Official Competition at Cannes last year. Gabrielle is currently in post for an adaptation of Eugene O'Neill's LONG DAY'S JOURNEY INTO NIGHT starring Jessica Lange and Ed Harris, and Karim Aïnouz's latest film MOTEL DESTINO premiered in Official Competition at Cannes this year.



Valentina Brazzini

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The Bureau is an established, BAFTA winning, production company known for its work with some of the UK's most distinctive film makers, from Asif Kapadia, to Harry Wootliff, Aleem Khan, and Andrew Haigh.

Recent films include THE STRAYS with Netflix, which launched at number one on the platform in the UK, and spent its opening weeks in the top ten in 89 territories; SUPERNOVA starring Colin Firth and Stanley Tucci; Aleem Khan's AFTER LOVE, for which Joanna Scanlan won a BAFTA for best Actress; and Harry Wootliff's TRUE THINGS starring Ruth Wilson and Tom Burke.

THE BUREAU

The Bureau previously produced Andrew Haigh's 45 YEARS for which Charlotte Rampling was Oscar nominated, and upcoming productions include QUEEN AT SEA starring Juliette Binoche, and Andrew Haigh's next film, which will shoot in the autumn of 2024. The Bureau is currently in co-production with Eye Eye Pictures (Norway) on Dara Van Dusen's debut feature, and Tessalit (France) on Meryem Benm'Barek's second film.

Janine has produced over thirty films, frequently working with co-production partners from across the world, structuring complex co-productions and has had films selected in competition at many international festivals including, Venice, Toronto, Sundance, Cannes, SXSW, Berlin and Rotterdam.

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Revolution Films is a British film and TV production company, founded in 1994 by director Michael Winterbottom alongside producer Andrew Eaton. The company's lead producer is now Melissa Parmenter.

Revolution Films have made a number of film and television productions since 1994, including JUDE, THE ROAD TO GUANTANAMO, 24 HOUR PARTY PEOPLE, EVERYDAY, RUSH and hit TV series THE TRIP (as well as its follow-ups THE TRIP TO ITALY and THE TRIP TO SPAIN).

Their movies have been in official competition at Berlin Film Festival seven times, Cannes Film Festival five times and had 17 North America Premieres at Toronto International Film Festival and Sundance. 

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Tearaway Films Limited is led by Michael Chamberlain and John Palfery-Smith to make feature film content for the international market. Prior to Tearaway, Michael ran Stampede for 16 years, specialising in internationally distributed documentaries. John has been a prolific Line Producer, now Co-Producer and Producer on feature films for other companies, including BRIAN & CHARLES (BAFTA-nominated); RISE OF THE FOOTSOLDIER (2019); SEE HOW THEY RUN, as Production Consultant (2022).

Tearaway has a slate of features in development, such as ALIEN VS BUS DRIVERS, based on a true story, from EMMY-winning writers of VEEP, Andy Riley & Kevin Cecil, with director Curtis Vowell and RIOT QUEENS, set in 1966, about the first ever LGBTQ riot against police oppression in America.

TEARAWAY FILMS

Michael has made over 150 individual films or series for UK's Channel 4, ITV, BBC and for Arte, HBO and other international channels. His feature documentary THE WORLD BEFORE HER (d/p. Nisha Pahuja) was nominated for an EMMY and won Best Documentary at Tribeca. Upon its release in India it became its most successful theatrical documentary ever. With Brazilian Director Jose Padilha (NARCOS, ROBOCOP etc) he won the Maysles Best Documentary prize for feature documentary SECRETS OF THE TRIBE for BBC, arte and HBO, which screened at over 50 festivals worldwide.

As Executive Producer, Michael broke the trailblazing drama strand DOGMA TV which broke writers such as Jack Lothian and continued for the next 12 years as COMING UP for Channel4, which uncovered writing talents like Jack Thorne, DC Moore, Nick Mohammed and directors Andrea Arnold, Tom Harper, Paul Andrew Williams, Toby Haynes, Tom MacRae, China Moo-Young, Wayne Yip, Luke Snellin, Yann Demange.
